On Tuesday, May 16, 2006, the Channelview Independent School District Board of Trustees approved a Standardized Dress Code policy to be followed at the elementary schools (Cobb, DeZavala, Hamblen) beginning the 2006-2007 school year. All clothing may be purchased at the store of your choice including area Wal-Mart stores. All students will be required to adhere to the District Dress Code plus the guidelines listed below:

- A plain colored polo shirt for each grade level, tucked in (If a shirt is worn under the polo shirt it must be white.)
- Black, navy or khaki standard 4 pocket pants/Capri/walking shorts or skorts only (no shorter than 4" above the knee)
- Blue jeans on Fridays with a school spirit/school organization shirt
- Black or brown belts worn if pants/ Capri/ shorts/ skorts have belt loops
- Tennis or dress shoes (No flip-flops, backless shoes or house shoes. Shoes designed to be fastened must be fastened appropriately.)
- Light weight jacket (A light black or grade level colored jacket may be worn inside the building.)
- During cold weather a sweat shirt that matches the grade level color may be worn untucked.

The following are the grade level colors for the 2006-2007 school year:

4 <sup>th</sup> Grade:	Light (Oxford) Blue
5 <sup>th</sup> Grade	Pale Yellow
6 <sup>th</sup> Grade	Maroon
