Please Note: Teachers who wish a value of ESNU to display on the report card must consistently use ESNU on the Scores page. No numeric grades should be entered on the Scores page.

ESNU and Progress Reports

ESNU marks from the scores page cannot be transferred to the IPR page. You will need to manually type in the ESNU values in the **Marks** column on the IPR page.
