

ESNU Scores

If you teach a course that uses an ESNU grading scale, you may enter those values on the **Scores, IPR, and RC** pages.

Letter Values Acceptable in CVISD

	<p>The following can be used in a course with a numeric or ESNU grading scale on the Scores page only:</p> <p>ABS = absent (does not count in student's average) EX = exempt (does not count in student's average) NM = no mark (does not count in student's average) NTI = Not Turned In (counts as zero in student's average)</p> <p><u>However, these codes should not be used as IPR or RC grades.</u></p>	<p>The following are used only for courses that do not use a numeric scale on the Scores page:</p> <p>E = Excellent S = Satisfactory N = Needs Improvement U = Unsatisfactory</p> <p><u>These codes can be used as IPR and RC grades.</u></p>

Defining ESNU Categories - define categories as shown in the **Define Categories** instructions. You may enter numeric values for category weights.

Creating ESNU Assessments - create assessments as shown in the **Create Assessments** instructions. You may enter numeric values for points and assessment weight.

ESNU marks from the scores page cannot be transferred to the IPR page. You will need to manually type in the ESNU values in the **Marks** column on the IPR page.

If you have recorded ESNU grades on your **Scores** page, and click the **Load From Gradebook** button on your IPR page, a blank will appear in the **Marks** slot.
